Category A	(amateurs 20-29)	8 rounds	11:00 a.m.
Category B	(seniors 1, 30-39)	7 rounds	11:00 a.m.
Category C	(seniors 2, 40-49)	7 rounds	13:30 p.m.
Category D	(seniors 3, 50-59)	6 rounds	13:30 p.m.
Category E	(woman, 20 and older)	4 rounds	09:00 a.m.
Category F	(female apprentices until 19)	4 rounds	09:00 a.m.
Category G	(male apprentices up to 19)	4 rounds	09:00 a.m.
Category H	(veterans 1, 60-69)	5 rounds	09:00 a.m.
Category I	(veterans 2, 70 and older)	3 rounds	09:00 a.m.

A hobby race also takes place as part of the bakers' cycling world championship. Racing cyclists with and without a license are eligible to start. There is a common start and a rating according to men and women in age groups up to 45 years and from 46 years. Prizes up to 5th place will be awarded.
